ADMISSIONS AND WITHDRAWAL –

1. The school will accept all admissions as stipulated under the requirements of the Right to Education Act.
2. Admissions are open to all grades, subject to the availability of seats.
3. For fresh admission, parents should apply in the prescribed forms along with the Admission form, Passport size photos of student, Passport size photos of parents and guardians, Transfer Certificate from Previous school, Report card of Previous class, Health Certificate issued by Registered Medical Practitioner, Original Photocopies of:
 - a) Birth Certificate along with the original
 - b) Aadhar Card of Parents and student
 - c) Samagra ID
 - d) Address Proof (present)
4. Fees in full is payable for the whole year, even if a student does not attend the school for any term or part thereof.
5. Notice of withdrawal and application for “Transfer Certificate” (TC) shall be submitted to the Principal, stating the reason for withdrawal, at least one months in advance or BEFORE 31st March, whichever is earlier. If the TC application is not submitted before 31st March, it will be deemed that the ward is continuing in the school for the following academic year. Withdrawal without proper notice period annuls the opportunity for another student and hence TC will be issued only on payment of full fees of following one term.
6. Transfer certificate will be issued only after payment of full fees and on submission of the No Dues Certificate from all pertinent departments.
7. If a student is absent to school without information for 7 (seven) working days continuously, his/her name be stuck off from the school record.

FEE – RULES

1. All fees and dues shall be paid in advance, before the due dates of four quarters mentioned in the guidelines.
2. A late fees of Rs.10/- is payable for fees paid after due date.
3. If the fee is not paid before last day of the month given, name of defaulters shall be removed from the Rolls on the first working day of the following month and a re-admission fee shall be paid.
4. Parents shall pay the fees only at cash counters at the school campuses. No one other than the cashier is authorized to collect or receive fees unless otherwise notified by the management.
5. Parents shall obtain signed receipts for all remittances made to the school.
6. Parents are advised not to send any fees through their wards.
7. Parents are encouraged to use the e-FEE system to pay the fees directly to the prescribed Bank account and send copy of the fees remittance slip by email or through their ward to the class teacher.
8. Transfer Certificate or any other certificate will not be issued unless all fees and fines are settled in full.

9. Caution deposits, will not be refunded, under any circumstance, without producing the receipt for the same. To make good of damages made by mystery students, 50% of the caution deposit will be deducted from the caution deposit at the time of issue of TC.

10. Parents shall keep the fees receipts in safe custody and produce them, when required by the school principal. No copies of receipts shall be issued from the office for any reasons.

11. Parents who wish to obtain Annual Fee Certificate for IT purpose shall submit application with full information at least 2 weeks in advance.

12. Fees once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

13. Fee cheques should be drawn in favour of –Vedaant Vidhyakulum.

14. Cheque return charges would be Rs 500/-

SCHOOL CONVEYANCE

School Conveyance facilities are available. The details of routes, bus timings, conveyance charges, timings, etc., may be obtained from the school office.

1. A conveyance fee is fixed for a full month. Hence reduction in conveyance fees will not be allowed for availing bus facility for periods less than one month.

2. Transport charges are subject to change as per the hike in diesel rate.

3. The school has right to change the bus no. and bus stop according to its own convenience at any time (in case of any problem).

FOOD FACILITY

I) SHORT BREAK

- Parents are requested to send healthy food options with quantity appropriate to the age and appetite of the student. **Here are the options for a month:**
- Kindly make sure not to repeat any food option in a month for variety of healthy intakes by a child.
- Pupils are encouraged to bring and use spoon for their snacks. Parents are advised to send snacks with a serviette. Pupils may bring water to drink during the day in a clean water bottle. Water dispensers are provided for them to refill their bottles during the day.
- Fizzy drinks, chewing/bubble gums, etc., are not allowed on the school premises at anytime.

II) SHORT BREAK

- Parents are requested to send any seasonal fruit.

III) LUNCH FACILITY

- Will be provided by the school.

ATTENDANCE RULES

1. All students should be regular & punctual in attending the school. Minimum 75% attendance is must.
2. Students should not remain absent from the school without prior permission. Parents should send a written application in case their wards want a leave.
3. If any student remains absent continuously for 7 days without permission or an application, his/her name is likely to be struck off the roll. Re-admission then will be at the discretion of the Principal/Secretary.

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. Students are advised to keep their class rooms/school building/campus as neat as possible and throw leftovers into the dustbins only.
2. Lending or borrowing of money and other articles is not permitted.
3. The school is not responsible for goods lost. It is not advisable to bring valuable articles (like expensive watches or fountain pens) to school.
4. There should be perfect harmony amongst the students.
5. The student is expected to come prepared with his academic difficulties to facilitate clarification.
6. Students should be clean and neatly dressed. The school uniform is to be worn everyday and for all school functions. Students who are sloppily dressed or not in the complete uniform will be sent home. They must carry their identity card daily. Low waist skirts for girls and low waist trousers for boys are strictly prohibited.
7. Non-Sikh boys should get their hair cut at regular intervals. (Sikh boys must wear turbans in class VI and above). A patka may be worn only while playing games.
8. During school picnics, excursions, extra classes conducted by school and for any other school visits, students must report only in the school/house uniform along with students ID Card.
9. Parents and guardians are not allowed to visit their wards or teachers in the classrooms, without the permissions of the Principal.
10. As far as possible, once a child comes to school, he/she should not be asked to come home on half day or leave from any period. No half day leave will be sanctioned.
11. No parents are allowed to pick up the child unless it is an emergency.
12. In case if a child is sick, can only come for appearing in test & then can leave
13. In case the parents are leaving the town, they should make sure that the tickets are scheduled according to school timings.
14. In case of emergencies, parents should report to the office at least half an hour before the departure of student.
15. In case, a child is sick the school doctor will contact parents, if your child has been sick in the morning, it is advisable not to send the child to school at all.
16. No student will be allowed to go home without the written permission of the Principal.
17. It is mandatory for all students, unless instructed otherwise to be present for festivals and functions celebrated in the school.

18. The school is committed to protecting the environment and expects to students to be environment friendly in all their actions. The use of poly bags (plastic bags) is, therefore, strictly prohibited in the school and students should consciously avoid their use for any purpose.
19. Girls are not allowed to apply henna on their hands. They are not allowed to wear ear ring or rings on fingers or nose rings. However, one pair of small ear studs is permitted.
20. Child can wear color dress on his/her birthday and can distribute chocolates to his classmates and can also cut the cake (eggless). No gifts distribution is permissible. Children can only bring saplings to school.
21. In case parents wish to meet the subject teachers prior appointment has to be taken either through Communicator or through school office. Appointment to meet subject teachers on working day will only be considered during their free periods on that particular day if it is urgent.
22. Students should bring the school diary and day wise scheduled books regularly to the school. Unnecessary books and note books should not be brought to school to make the school bag heavy.
23. It is the responsibility of the students to ensure the signature of parents on: notes in the Communicator, test copies and report card.
24. Circulars given time to time should be read carefully by the students and the parent to avoid inconvenience.
25. An identity card shall be issued to each student. Replacement of lost I-card will be done on payment of Rs 50/- along with a written application signed by the parent.
26. All the belongings must be marked with name, class and section of the child.

DISCIPLINE RULES

Discipline is an integral part of the school culture. The School encourages self-discipline that arises from within and remains throughout life. Some general rules of discipline to be followed are:-

- Students are expected to maintain discipline within the school campus and in class.
- Students should be neatly dressed and enter the campus only in proper school uniform at all times unless instructed otherwise. Student ID card should be worn at all times while in school.
- Students should remain within the school campus during school hours and not venture out on any pretext. . Adequate snacks and stationery should be brought.
- Students must keep their class and surroundings clean and not litter.
- Mobile phones, cameras, radios or any other gadgets are strictly prohibited inside the school premises.
- Care must be taken of all school property and if any damage is done, it will be made good by the concerned student together with a fine imposed for the offence.
- Our students are expected to speak only in English right from the moment they enter the school premises and also inside school vans.
- Discipline and good behaviour should be maintained inside the school vans.
- Bullying is strictly not allowed and action will be taken if any case of bullying is observed.
- Students should not have parties in their classrooms or in the school premises.
- All tests and evaluations are compulsory and exemption from evaluations will not be considered unless on medical grounds supported with evidence.

- Taking leave during working days is strongly discouraged. Parents are responsible to make up for the loss of the studies in case of leave taken. The school will expect these students to be at par with the class in every way and that must be ensured by the parents only.
- Any kind of tour or picnic undertaken by students in groups should have the support of parents and elders should accompany them.
- Any mass movement during school time should be in a silence and in an orderly fashion.
- Students should not indulge in any anti-social activity, in or outside the school.

- Students found tampering with the school records as marks allotted by teachers in tests/ exam or any school property will be liable to strict disciplinary action.
- Bursting of crackers and playing with colors any other such unwanted activity is liable to lead to expulsion of a student from the school.
- Switching off lights / fans, clean boards (when not in use) has to be taken care of.
- As we all are same so avoid any kind of discussion on: Caste and Communalism.
- Students are encouraged to maintain a simple lifestyle and keep away from Flamboyance. Please cooperate to ensure that proper discipline is maintained inside and outside school premises.
- The school reserves the right to suspend or to take strict disciplinary action against a student whose performance in studies is constantly unsatisfactory or whose conduct is harmful to other students.

BUS RULES

1. The student shall be at the bus stop specified, at least 5 minutes ahead of the prescribed time. Those who miss the bus shall make their own arrangement to reach the school.
2. Deviation from approved route or picking up from home will not be allowed to reduce the effective time of travel of students and avoid unwanted delays.
3. If a change in collection point / stop is desired, the same shall be communicated by the parent through a written note to the Transport Supervisor with date and clear instructions at least one day before.
4. Instructions from parents on any change required in conveyance received over phone from parents or guardians shall not be entertained for safety reasons.

5. Parents, whose wards would not be travelling in the school bus, are requested to notify the Bus Attendant or the Transport Supervisor in advance, about their absence.
6. Pupils using school transport are expected to:
 - Remain in the seat given by the driver/attendant at all times.
 - Listen to the instructions from the driver/attendant.
 - Avoid behavior that could distract the driver, as this could be dangerous.
 - Keep emergency exits and aisles free of bags, musical instruments and sports items.
 - Behave in a good manner when waiting at the bus stop and when walking to and from the bus stop
7. Without the prior permission of the principal/administrator, students cannot board any bus, other than their own, not get down anywhere other than their own stops.

8. Parents are not expected to talk / get any information from the drivers and the attendants, as it will affect the time schedule. For any information or complaints against the drivers or the attendants or about the transport arrangements, parents shall contact the transport supervisor.
9. If there is no one to receive the child at the stop, the child will be brought back to the school and wither of the parents will have to come and escort the child home. This will be followed strictly.
10. Parents are not allowed to enter the bus under any circumstances.
11. Objects of any kind must not be disposed off inside or out of the bus.
12. The school is keen to encourage pupils to take responsibility for their behavior on the buses in the interests of the safety and welfare of all. Serious or repeated incidents of misbehavior may result in pupils receiving a ban from using the bus. Parents are required to support the school by ensuring their children behave responsibly on the school bus
13. Under no circumstances students should touch the instrument panel of buses.

LIBRARY RULES

The school has a well equipped library for the benefit of the students. The books are issued under following conditions-

- Books are issued for a period of one week. Only one book will be issued at a time.
- Before issue of a book in his/her name, the students should check it and point out any damage in the book. If the book is not returned on the due date then a fine of Rs 10 per day will be charged.
- Folding the corners of pages, tearing the pages and writing unnecessary material, will be treated as damage entitling the students to deposit the cost of the book.
- In case of loss of book, students will be required to pay the cost of book or replace the book.
- Books must be returned to the library before the commencement of the annual examination.

HOMEWORK GUIDELINES

- All home works are required to be completed and submitted within the prescribed time.
- Try to ensure that your child has a well-lit working area (maybe a bedroom or dining room) but preferably away from any distractions like T.V and Radio (Noise areas).

- Try to show an interest in your child's work both at home and at school. Listen to problems; ask him/her about their day but without making this an ordeal.
- **If your child is having difficulties, you may guide, but don't do the work for them!**
- If a student seems to spend more time on homework than expected, parents may inform the school by making a note on the diary
- Pupils who do not complete a homework task will have their diary stamped with warning and a new date to submit.
