GUIDELINES FOR THE PARENTS—

Please make sure that your children are in touch with their text books during the vacation.

Regular reading and revision must be a part of their daily routine.

Encourage your child to read as many story books as possible and help them to maintain a

personal library. Take them to a book shop and encourage them to choose and buy some books. Converse with them in English and acquaint them with new words everyday.
